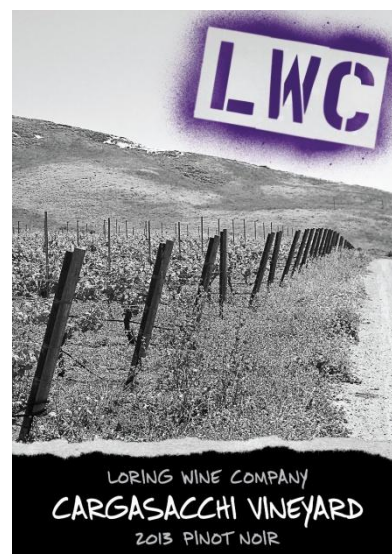




Loring Wine Company 2013 Cargasacchi Vineyard Pinot Noir

Cargasacchi Vineyard is located in the southern valley of the Sta. Rita Hills. Planted in calcareous soils, the fruit is usually very deep and well structured.

Deep ruby. Heady red and dark berry aromas are complicated by mocha, licorice and Indian spices, with a smoky element in the background. The palate offers intense black raspberry and bitter cherry flavors that gain sweetness and depth with air. This powerful yet lithe pinot finishes with strong thrust and fine-grained tannins that add grip.

Medium ruby color; deep, earthy, wild plum aromas with pepper notes; deep, ripe, plum and cherry flavors, with earthy notes; good structure and balance; long finish. Complex, earthy Pinot with terrific structure. Pair with slow-roasted pork.
