

Medium-deep ruby color; complex, earthy, dark cherry aromas with oak and anise notes; deep, complex, dark cherry flavors with savory spice and anise notes; some oak; silky texture; good structure and balance; long finish. Spicy, rich Pinot with really nice layered flavors.

Winemaker Brian Loring's take on this coveted vineyard shows rhubarb, pencil lead and a very clove-y cinnamon aspect on the nose. Raspberries mark the core of the palate, but the edges are speckled with strong herbs, from oregano to juniper. It offers a great mix of fruit and spice.

Alluring, with a supple core of blueberry, plum and raspberry flavors. Stays true to form throughout, ending with a pleasing push of ripe fruit and fine-grained tannins.
