**90 Points**

Dark red. Energetic raspberry and cherry aromas show very good clarity and a hint of smokiness. Tangy red berry flavors are complicated by peppery herbs and spices, gaining depth and structure with air. Finishes with appealing sweetness, resonating floral character and smooth, slow-building tannins.

### **Greg Walter (Pinot Report)**

**92 Points**

Medium ruby color; rich, earthy, stewed cherry aromas; forward, rich stewed cherry and plum flavors with pepper notes; good structure and balance; long finish. Earthy Pinot with nice spicy notes. Great with roast chicken.
