Brilliant ruby-red. Sexy black raspberry and spicecake aromas show very good clarity and pick up a note of cola with air. Emphatically fruity and open-knit, offering lively red and dark berry flavors and a kick of white pepper. Seamless and sweet on a finish that lingers with very good spicy persistence. This flamboyant, fruit-driven pinot is ridiculously easy to drink.

Medium-deep ruby color; complex and deep plum aromas with pepper and anise notes; complex, full, ripe plum and cherry flavors with pepper and oak notes; good structure and balance; long finish. Deep, full Pinot with the structure for some age.
