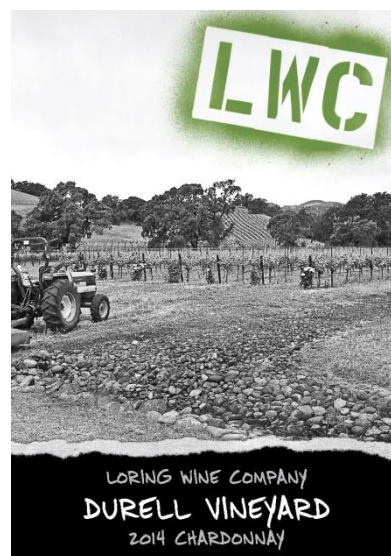




Loring Wine Company 2014 Durell Vineyard Chardonnay

Durell Vineyard is located in the Petaluma Gap region of the Sonoma Coast AVA. The area is actually quite warm - as such the fruit doesn't retain much acidity. The lower acid profile leads to the rounder, softer, slightly oily mouth feel that Durell Vineyard Chardonnays are known for.

Slow to unfold but does so gracefully, revealing a mix of pear, butterscotch, baked apple and baking spice flavors, gaining depth and nuance on the finish

PinotFile - Prince of Pinot

Moderate golden yellow color and clear in the glass. Complex nose leads off with aromas of lemon, peach, apple, white flower blossom and spice. Noticeably smooth in the mouth with vivid flavors of lemon and grilled peach. This wine sports admirable balance and a deft integration of oak.
