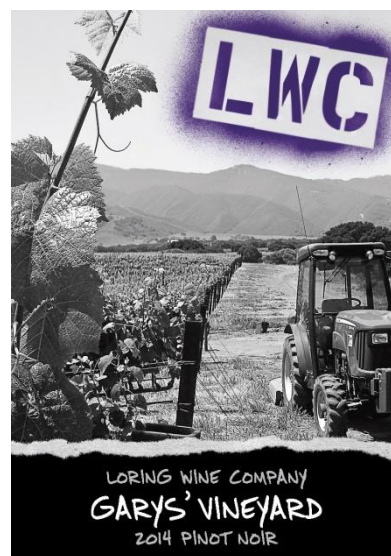




Loring Wine Company 2014 Garys' Vineyard Pinot Noir

93 Points

An impressive Pinot Noir, clearly New World in style, showing its California roots in sunshiny ripeness, yet with a crisp bite of acidity. You'll find upfront sour red cherry candy and bitter cranberry flavors, but also a tannic edge of black tea. The finish is wonderful: dry, long, rich and spicy. It's a wine that grows more complex as it breathes and warms in the glass, offering ever more earthiness, mushroominess, minerality.

Medium ruby color; lovely aromas of blue fruit and red cherry with floral notes; rich and deep flavors of blueberry and cherry with subtle cranberry notes; silky texture with some tannins; good structure and balance; long finish. Subtle and silky Pinot with layers of flavor.

Josh Raynolds (Vinous / Tanzer)

92-93 Points

Vivid ruby. Expansive aromas of fresh dark berries, incense and potpourri are brightened by an intense spicy nuance. Silky, seamless and broad on the palate, offering sweet black raspberry and boysenberry flavors complemented by a suave rose pastille note. Finishes very long and sappy, with resonating floral character and smooth, fully integrated tannins.

A ripe red cherry, incense, delicate spice, florals, and graphite in the nose. The palate offers up a bright, crisp entry with a core of polished black fruits.
