

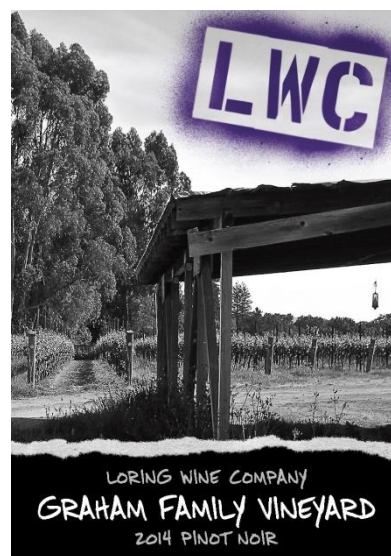


Loring Wine Company 2014 Graham Family Vineyard Pinot Noir

94 Points

Raspberries, cherries, pomegranates, with crisp, Lifesaver candy acidity and a gentle scour of tannins. There's oak in there, not too much, and the alcohol is moderate. The result is a savory, delicious wine for drinking now and over the next five years. The smokiness suggests lamb chops, and you can throw in some roasted new potatoes with butter and rosemary.

PinotFile - Prince of Pinot

91 Points

Moderate reddish purple color in the glass. This wine brings the senses to attention with a hi-tone perfume of black cherry, raspberry, spice and toasty oak. Nearly full bodied, with a charge of Bing cherry flavor that saturates the mouth with sappy goodness. Accents of cola and oak add interest. Impressive balance with suave tannins and flawless integration of acidity, finishing with plenty of cherry goodness.

Greg Walter (Pinot Report)

91 Points

Medium-deep ruby color; forward black cherry aromas with oak and spice notes; rich and mouthfilling dark cherry flavors with velvety texture; good structure and balance; long finish. Forward and rich Pinot with velvety texture.

90 Points

The nose is an alluring supple caramel, sticky cherry fruit. The palate is raspberry and cherry with nice bright vigor and good length.
