

Kessler-Haak Vineyard is located in the northern valley of the Sta. Rita Hills next door to Clos Pepe Vineyard. Planted in sandy soils, the fruit is usually very deep, well structured, and shows a lot of depth and baking spice character.

Fresh and lively, with dense, complex blueberry, boysenberry and raspberry notes folding together. Tightly focused, rich and expansive on the aftertaste, where the flavors linger.

Greg Walter (Pinot Report)

Medium-deep ruby color; dark, intense and smoky black cherry aromas framed by spicy oak notes; deep and strong black cherry flavors with a significant oak influence; good structure and balance; long finish. Big, smoky and spicy Pinot that's a little monolithic now, but may tame with age.

Tightly focused red fruit and botanical notes. The palate is tightly focused red cranberry finishing with bright freshness and an ethereal lightness overall.
