Santa Lucia Highlands PINOT NOIR

Medium-deep ruby color; rich floral aromas with blueberry and dark plum notes; complex, rich, dark blue and red fruit flavors with stone and mineral shadings; good structure and balance; long finish. Deep and earthy Pinot with depth for age.

Josh Raynolds (Vinous / Tanzer)

90-91 Points

Vivid ruby-red. Sexy, assertive aromas of candied raspberry and cherry, with an emphatic spicy overtone. Silky and expansive on the palate, offering juicy red berry and rose pastille flavors that deepen with air. Fruit-driven, smooth Pinot with very soft tannins building slowly on the finish.

Instantly attractive attention to the nose - rich, spicy, orange, nutmeg, anise, and delicate florals. The palate entry is forward and ripe with a concentration of boysenberry and raspberry in the core. Precise red fruits along with notes of sassafras through the finish with nice texture.
