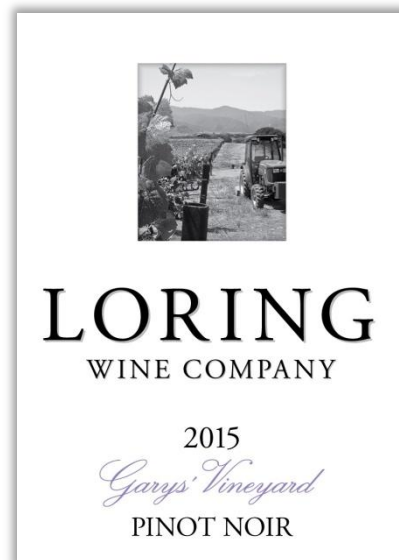




# Loring Wine Company 2015 Garys' Vineyard Pinot Noir

This bottling is so delicious in cherries and plums, and so balanced in acidity, oak and tannins, you'd be hard pressed to find something better to drink now with filet mignon, grilled salmon or ahi tuna.

Medium-light to medium ruby; attractive, forward, fragrant, complex, raspberry and black cherry fruit aroma with hints of baking spices, mocha, and forest floor; medium to medium-full body; deep, rich, fleshy, cherry and red berry fruit flavors with bright acidity, a hint of cola, and a velvety mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Forward and accessible now, though poised for further development and complexity with a few more years of bottle aging. Very highly recommended.

**Prince of Pinot (PinotFile)** **90 Points**

Moderate reddish purple color in the glass. The nose is endowed with aromas of blueberry, black raspberry and a hint of nutty oak. Rich entry of black cherry, blueberry and black raspberry fruits, rich middle, and a rich finish. There is deft integration of oak and tannin on the palate, and the finish offers pleasing spiced cherry goodness and some length along with the richness.
