

Sadly, our last Keefer Ranch Pinot ever. Marcy Keefer has sold the vineyard, so we've decided to move on. And, as often happens, we've saved the best for last. An amazingly bright and deeply scented wine, we notes of cherry, raspberry, and baking spices. Deeply concentrated with amazingly deep cherry, raspberry, and plum flavors. Super soft, supple, velvety mouthfeel. A completely captivating and super sexy wine.

On the spectrum of Pinot Noir, this bottling plays it down the middle: rich, but tart; fruity, yet elusive; dry, yet sweet in fruit. The raspberries and pomegranates have a touch of bitter cranberry, which certainly makes the mouth water. The oak is perfect, bringing sweet toast, vanilla and wood sap to the formula. And the finish is dry and long in fruity essence and cola spice. All in all, a lovely Pinot Noir, delicate and feminine, super-drinkable now.
