Winemaker Tasting Notes

Medium-deep ruby color; rich floral aromas with blueberry and dark plum notes; complex, rich, dark blue and red fruit flavors with stone and mineral shadings; good structure and balance; long finish. Deep and earthy Pinot with depth for age.

Medium-light to medium ruby; attractive, assertive, black cherry and red berry fruit aroma with herbal notes and hints of rhubarb and forest floor; medium to medium-full body; deep, moderately rich, spicy, red fruit flavors with a velvety mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Elegantly styled and shows appealing fruit, though a bit tight at present, deserving another year or two of bottle aging. Very highly recommended.
