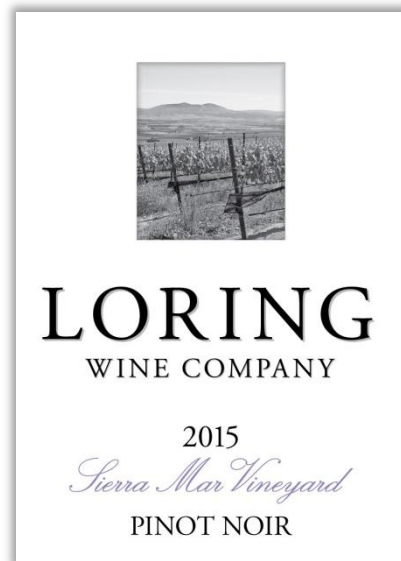




Loring Wine Company 2015 Sierra Mar Vineyard Pinot Noir

A new wine in the vintage is the 2015 Pinot Noir Sierra Mar Vineyard, which should certainly be outstanding. Offering lots of blackberry, wild herbs, spring flower and hints of toasted bread, it's fresh and lively, with lots of nuances and complexity, as well as seamless on the palate.

Strikes a careful balance between the exuberance of its fruit and the integrity of its structure. The result is just fine, perfect for upscale drinking wherever Pinot-friendly food requires liquid partnership. The raspberries, cherries and plums have a mushroomy earthiness. The tannic grip is refined, the acidity mouthwatering. Really a nice example of Pinot Noir's silky, sexy nature.

Medium-light ruby color; attractive, spicy, plum and cherry fruit aroma with herbal notes; medium to medium-full body; rich, slightly plush, fleshy, black cherry and blackberry fruit flavors with good depth, a touch of vanilla, and a velvety mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Very tempting and enjoyable to drink now, though best to age for several more years. Very highly recommended.

Prince of Pinot (PinotFile)

Moderate reddish purple color in the glass. Shy aromas of black cherry, bark and spice lead off. In the mouth, the core of blackberry, cassis and spice flavors are very satisfying. There is a deft touch of oak, balanced tannins and overall harmony and poise.
