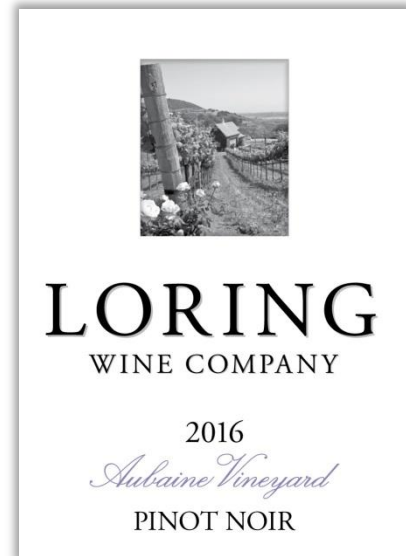

The 2016 Pinot Noir Aubaine Vineyard reveals a medium ruby-purple color and nose of crushed red cherries, mulberries and pomegranate with fragrant hints of potpourri, lavender and dried Provence herbs. Medium-bodied with a tightly-wound, vibrantly fruited palate, it has a fine-grained tannic frame and plenty of freshness, finishing long and perfumed.

It has an old-school feel in its darker cherry and currant fruits, leafy herbs and underbrush/forest floor-laced bouquet. This gives way to a medium-bodied, beautifully balanced, elegant 2016 that has bright acidity and a clean, layered texture that keeps you coming back to the glass. It's a beautiful wine from this estate that will keep for 5-7 years.
