From a site located on the southern edge of the Sta. Rita Hills, the 2016 Pinot Noir Rancho La Viña Vineyard has a pretty, complex, candied red fruited profile that has a plenty of sappy flower character that shows more with time in the glass. One of the more fresh, lively wines from Loring, with medium-bodied richness, a tight, vibrant texture, bright yet integrated acidity and a good finish, it will be better in 1-2 years and keep through 2026.
