The 2016 Pinot Noir Pinot Noir Bulldozer Red comes from a site in Paso Robles, and it's certainly a variety you don't see often from this region. It was completely destemmed and saw 10 months in 15% new French oak. Its deeper (yet still translucent) ruby color is followed by a fruit forward, layered, beautifully balanced 2016 that has lots of red and black currant fruit, toasted spice, smoked earth and licorice aromas and flavors. Don't let the appellation scare you, this offers real Pinot Noir character, is balanced and has loads to love.
