Dark garnet color in the glass. Brooding aromas of fertile earth and wine cave. A charge of boisterous black raspberry and blackberry fruit greets the palate, fills every nook and cranny in the mouth, and exits with aplomb. Velvety in texture with noticeable, but not intrusive tannins.

California Grapevine 91 Points

Medium ruby; attractive, forward, deep, intense, spicy, cherry and red currant aroma with hints of cola and mocha; medium-full body; forward, rich, red and dark berry fruit flavors with good depth and balance, and a plush mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Developed with airing in the glass to show richness and some elegance, and deserving several more years of bottle aging. Very highly recommended.
