

Moderately dark garnet color in the glass. Grand aromas of purple grape, boysenberry and sandalwood. My first word after taking a sip was Wow! An ephemeral wine with flat-out delicious, well-spiced, dark red cherry fruit that really captures the palate with goodness. Wondrous harmony with endless aromatic pleasure on the finish. Medium-light ruby; attractive, forward, deep, intense, earthy, red cherry fruit aroma with hints of forest floor and Asian spices; medium body; rich, rounded, elegantly styled, red fruit flavors with good depth and acid balance, and some plushness in the velvety mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Very highly recommended.

Connoisseurs' Guide 90 Points

Scattered notes of savory spice sit lightly atop well-defined, ripe cherry fruit in the nicely composed, and, although a bit more substantial than most of its mates, the wine never strays too far to ripeness and shows fine balance throughout with nicely fit acidity lending buoyancy and tactile length. It is firm without erring to stiffness and can be enjoyed in the near term, but it is built to improve with age and deserves at least a couple years of forbearance in order to grow into its best.
