Moderately light garnet color in the glass. Likable aromas of dark cherry, ripe peach and nutty oak. A middleweight style with a tasty core of nicely spiced black cherry fruit and an underpinning of nutty oak. Excellent harmony and easy approachability.

California Grapevine

Medium-light to medium ruby; attractive, forward, rich, seductive, red cherry and berry fruit aroma with hints of forest floor and baking spices; medium to medium-full body; rich, fleshy, red fruit flavors with good acid balance, a hint of cocoa, and some plushness in the mouthfeel; medium to medium-full tannin; lingering aftertaste. Very enjoyable now and should continue to develop with a few more years of bottle aging. Very highly recommended.
