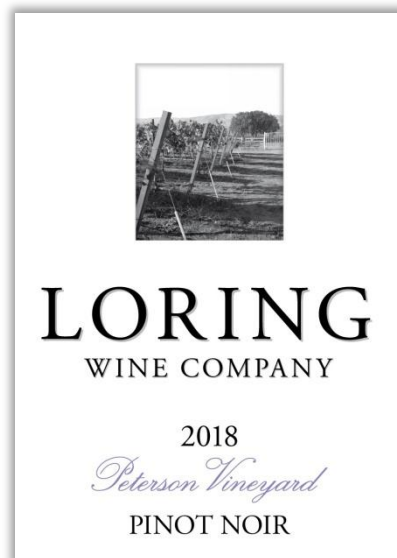




# Loring Wine Company 2018 Peterson Vineyard Pinot Noir

The vineyard has a perfect Southeast exposure overlooking the Salinas River Valley and benefits from the unique SLH terroir.

Coming from the Santa Lucia Highlands, the 2018 Pinot Noir Peterson Vineyard offers more Bing cherry, strawberries, violets, and forest floor notes as well as slightly more structure and tannic grip on the palate. It looks to be another rounded, textured, beautifully balanced wine from Loring.
