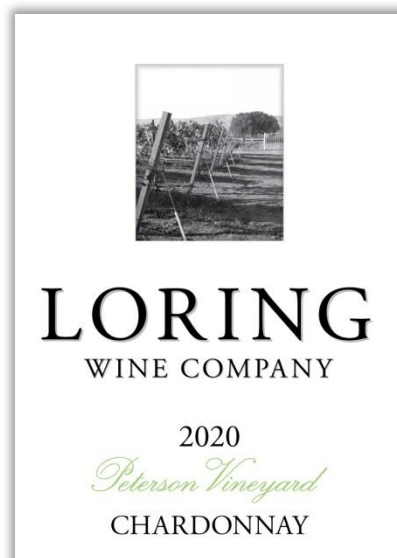




Loring Wine Company 2020 Peterson Vineyard Chardonnay

The Peterson Vineyard along River Road in the Santa Lucia Highlands is owned by John and Lynne Peterson and is the result of a 10-year effort to secure land in the Santa Lucia Highlands with the goal to grow premium pinot noir and chardonnay. The vineyard has a perfect Southeast exposure overlooking the Salinas River Valley and benefits from the unique SLH terroir.

Winemaker Notes

A bit sleeker than the Boekennoogen, it shares the mixed citrus nose and racy lemon and pear flavors, with notes of baking spices. Minerality dominates the finish. So fun and zippy - the perfect wine for shellfish and any dish with heavy sauces that require a wine that can cut through them. The closest thing to Chablis we've ever made. Yummy!!
