#### Winemaker Tasting Notes

Bright citrus notes on the nose followed by descendant lemon and pear flavors. Those flavors are highlighted by a creamy and bright mouth feel with hints of graham cracker. There's definitely some minerality on the racy finish. Sleeker and more edgy than past vintages, it tends to remind me somewhat of Chablis. Super yummy no matter how you describe it!
